PROJECT EAGLE UPDATE

May, 2011

The first major construction contract of the project has been awarded to Kiewit-Turner Joint Venture to perform the renovations of the former UPI Office Building, which will be known as Clinic Building South. This 120,000 square foot space will include areas for mental health outpatient services and administrative functions, in addition to a Department of Defense outpatient clinic for the United States Air Force. This contract also includes the demolition of select buildings on the site.

Kiewit-Turner is currently working on the beginning phases of the contract including installing the construction fence around the site and submitting their required paperwork. The scheduled completion of the 3rd and 4th floors is February 2012. The 3rd floor will be for administrative functions while the 4th floor will be for the USAF.

The Joint Venture Design Team has also created a large, 3D model of the new Medical Center. It is currently on display in the main atrium of the Denver VA Medical Center, and provides a great new perspective of the space. In the next couple of weeks, we will have booklets detailing the project and other visual productions available in the same area of the main atrium. If you haven't seen it yet, be sure to stop in the main atrium and check it out.
